



WEDDING FLOWERS AT ST CATHERINE'S

To the Bride and Groom and their Families

St. Catherine's Church, Gosfield, would like to help you make arrangements for your wedding in church so that your special day is perfect.

The flower arrangements in church can help to beautify your wedding service and the flower arrangers will help in anyway possible.

Your Options

1. You can do the flowers yourself or use your own florist. Please let us know, as our regular arranger will not need to place flowers in church that weekend.
2. You can accept the arrangement at the altar. These flowers are provided by a church flower arranger so do not expect them to follow a certain colour scheme.
3. You can discuss your wishes with a flower arranger and agree to provide the flowers or to contribute money for the cost of the arrangement.

At some times in the year the church will have flowers for a particular season. On these occasions wedding flowers will need to take this into account. During Lent and Advent flowers are not always present.

Arrangements can be in various places in the church, these should be discussed with Mrs James. Please note that, unless specific provision have been made, arrangements should not be removed until after the Sunday services, and should be cleared away during the following week or when they are no longer fresh. Decorations at pew ends should be removed before the church is locked on Saturday night. Flowers should be positioned so that no doors are blocked by pedestals (once it was impossible to enter the vestry to get at the church registers). Churchwardens ask that no nails or pins are used on woodwork.
